Comparing educational attainment for the working age population 25 - 64, Central Frontenac has significantly higher ratios for persons with no certificate, diploma or degree and in apprenticeship education than Ontario. But has a lower rate of university level education at a bachelor level and above.

TOP 7 INDUSTRIES REPRESENTING THE TOTAL LABOUR FORCE

64.4% (1165) of the total labour force in Central Frontenac is represented in 7 of 20 industry groups. Ontario has 57.0% of its total labour force in the same industries. Construction has the highest share of the labour force in Central Frontenac at 14.1% compared to Ontario at 6.8%.

POPULATION FACTS

In 2016, the population of Central Frontenac was 4373 a decrease of 4.0% or 183 people since the 2011 census. In comparison, the province of Ontario had an increase in population of 4.6% or 596,673 people.

61.4% of Central Frontenac's population is aged 15 – 64 compared to 66.8% for Ontario.

26.4% of Central Frontenac's population is 65 years and older compared to 16.7% for Ontario.

The median age for Central Frontenac is 53.5 and the median age for Ontario is 41.3.

This data indicates that Central Frontenac has an older workforce and population than Ontario. It also shows that Central Frontenac has a stagnant growth in population.

INCOME

Central Frontenac has a lower median total income than Ontario. Males in both Central Frontenac and Ontario have significantly higher incomes than females. Central Frontenac reports lower incomes for both males and females compared with males and females in Ontario.

73.4% of the population of Central Frontenac resided at the same address over the last 5 years compared to 62.9% for Ontario. Central Frontenac reported a significantly lower migration rate of persons from other countries than Ontario.

The occupational category of Trades, transport and equipment operators represent 21.7% of the labour force in Central Frontenac. This compares to 13.3% in Ontario. Sales and service occupations is the number one occupational category for Ontario at 23.4%.
