Comparing educational attainment for the working age population 25 - 64, Loyalist has a significantly higher ratio for persons with college education than Ontario. But has a significantly lower rate of university level education at a bachelor level and above.

## TOP 7 INDUSTRIES REPRESENTING THE TOTAL LABOUR FORCE

69.0% (5845) of the total labour force in Loyalist is represented in 7 of 20 industry groups. Ontario has 59.1% of its total labour force in the same industries. Health care and social services has the highest share of the labour force in Loyalist at 14.6% compared to Ontario at 10.8%.

## POPULATION FACTS

In 2016, the population of Loyalist was 16,971 an increase of 4.6% or 750 people since the 2011 census. In comparison, the province of Ontario had an increase in population of 4.6% or 596,673 people.

64.5% of Loyalist's population is aged 15 – 64 compared to 66.8% for Ontario.

20.1% of Loyalist's population is 65 years and older compared to 16.7% for Ontario.

The median age for Loyalist is 45 and the median age for Ontario is 41.3.

This data indicates that Loyalist has a slightly older workforce and population than Ontario. It also shows that Loyalist experienced a significant growth in population similar to Ontario.

## INCOME

Loyalist has a higher median total income than Ontario. Males in both Loyalist and Ontario have significantly higher incomes than females. Loyalist reports higher incomes for both males and females compared with males and females in Ontario.

63.9% of the population of Loyalist resided at the same address over the last 5 years compared to 62.9% for Ontario. Loyalist reported a significantly lower migration rate of persons from other countries than Ontario.
