In 2016, the population of Frontenac Islands was 1760 a decrease of 5.6% or 104 people since the 2011 census. In comparison, the province of Ontario had an increase in population of 4.6% or 596,673 people.

58.0% of Frontenac Islands's population is aged 15 – 64 compared to 66.8% for Ontario.

30.1% of Frontenac Islands's population is 65 years and older compared to 16.7% for Ontario.

The median age for Frontenac Islands is 55.9 and the median age for Ontario is 41.3.

This data indicates that Frontenac Islands has a significantly older workforce and population than Ontario. It also shows that Frontenac Islands experienced a stagnant growth in population.
