

In 2016, the population of Leeds and the Thousand Islands was 9465 an increase of 2.0% or 188 people since the 2011 census. In comparison, the province of Ontario had an increase in population of 4.6% or 596,673 people.

63.0% of Leeds and the Thousand Islands's population is aged 15 - 64 compared to 66.8% for Ontario.

23.0% of Leeds and the Thousand Islands's population is 65 years and older compared to 16.7% for Ontario.

The median age for Leeds and the Thousand Islands is 50.5 and the median age for Ontario is 41.3.

This data indicates that Leeds and the Thousand Islands has a much older workforce and population than Ontario. It also shows that Leeds and the Thousand Islands had a modest growth in population.
