Comparing educational attainment for the working age population 25 - 64, Rideau Lakes has a significantly higher ratio for persons with college education than Ontario. But has a lower rate of university level education at a bachelor level and above.

TOP 7 INDUSTRIES REPRESENTING THE TOTAL LABOUR FORCE

63.1% (2450) of the total labour force in Rideau Lakes is represented in 7 of 20 industry groups. Ontario has 59.1% of its total labour force in the same industries. Health care and social assistance has the highest share of the labour force in Rideau Lakes at 13.6% compared to Ontario at 10.8%.

POPULATION FACTS

In 2016, the population of Rideau Lakes was 10326 an increase of 1.2% or 119 people since the 2011 census. In comparison, the province of Ontario had an increase in population of 4.6% or 596,673 people.

60.5% of Rideau Lakes's population is aged 15 - 64 compared to 66.8% for Ontario.

27.5% of Rideau Lakes's population is 65 years and older compared to 16.7% for Ontario.

The median age for Rideau Lakes is 54 and the median age for Ontario is 41.3.

This data indicates that Rideau Lakes has an older workforce and population than Ontario. It also shows that Rideau Lakes has a growing population.

75.6% of the population of Rideau Lakes resided at the same address over the last 5 years compared to 62.9% for Ontario. Rideau Lakes reported a significantly lower migration rate of persons from other countries than Ontario.
