Summary: "Three on Thursday" - Participation Evaluation

A Series of Webinars delivered in 2020-2021 supporting human resource management in Kingston, Frontenac County, Leeds and Grenville United Counties and Loyalist Township

Background

In February 2020, the Eastern Workforce Innovation Board (EWIB) committed to the delivery of a series of training sessions to support the human resource practices of businesses in Frontenac County, Leeds and Grenville United Counties and Loyalist Township that would supplement EWIB's online Human Resource Hub, http://www.workforcedev.ca/index.php/en/human-resources-hub-en.

Like so many businesses and services across Canada, EWIB was required to modify this plan to meet pandemic restrictions and in early April pivoted to a series of three webinars promoted as "Three on Thursdays". The focus on human resource practices to support local business continued.

Product

Based on feedback from participants in business recovery taskforces established in Kingston, Frontenac County and Leeds and Grenville United Counties as well as local economic developers, three following workshops were selected:

To meet the growing concern with the mental health of business owners and their employees:

Mental Health in the Workplace – Facilitated by Jack Veitch, Manager Community Engagement and Education, Canadian Mental Health Association

- Difference between mental health and mental illness
- How to recognize the signs of mental distress in an employee
- Simple verbal de-escalation techniques and communication strategies
- Work plans for staff coming back into office during COVID-19
- Available community supports and referral strategies

Despite the pandemic, labour market shortages continued in key sectors. The following webinar continued to be relevant throughout the pandemic:

Recruiting and Retaining the Best – Facilitated by Sarah Delicate, Senior Partner of BBMD Consulting

- Reasons employees leave
- The high cost of employee turnover
- Rating your performance: Company culture, Hiring for fit and performance, Onboarding to fit in
- Making your employee feel valued

Finally, relatively stable population growth combined with an aging population in some areas, business owners are turning their attention to succession planning:

Succession Planning – Facilitated by Colleen Carruthers, Partner at TR Group Inc.

- Differentiating between Succession Planning and Business Continuity
- Exploring the steps of Succession Planning in a tight labour market
- Ensuring bench strength readiness for vital positions

Promotion
